NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs requires asbestos abatement services at the VA Southern Oregon Rehabilitation Center and Clinics in White City, Oregon. There are four rooms (approx. 416 sq. ft.) that need the asbestos-containing ceiling tile (ACT) removed and replaced along with six lights and two vent fans. This project must be done in two different phases. Rooms 105 and 106 will be addressed in the first phase, followed by Rooms 108 and 109 in the subsequent phase. This allows Canteen Services to access Storerooms 104 and Room 107 during construction. Items must be removed following ACM removal and ICRA procedures to prevent contamination of areas and people outside of ICRA barriers. For rooms 108 and 109 materials must be removed through the window. The award will be a firm-fixed-price contract with a magnitude of construction between \$100,000 and \$250,000. Questions must be submitted by April 16, 2025. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 5:00 PM PDT ON APRIL 28, 2025.

F -- MIMA LEAD ABATEMENT GOWING CLARK HOUSE (SOL)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The National Park Service requires lead paint abatement services at the Gowing Clark House at Minute Man National Historical Park in Concord, Massachusetts. The estimated magnitude of the complete requirement is between \$25,000 and \$100,000. The period of performance for the base contract is 60 days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed, starting on or around June 1, 2025, and ending on or about July 31, 2025. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 10:00 AM EDT ON MAY 12, 2025.
