F -- DURHAM ASBESTOS ABATEMENT SERVICES "SOLICITATION" (SOL)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) requires a contractor to perform asbestos floor removal services at the Durham VA Health Care System (VAHCS) in Durham, North Carolina. The contractor shall furnish all labor, supervision, materials, equipment, tools, and transportation necessary to remove asbestos-containing floor tile, mastic, stair tread coverings, and associated components in designated areas. All work shall comply with applicable Federal, State, and local regulations, including North Carolina HHCU requirements. The contractor shall perform all work necessary to complete the asbestos flooring removal using non-friable, non-regulated removal methods. Required services include mobilization and setup of containment; installation of protective barriers, signage, and site-control measures; removal of asbestos-containing floor tile, mastic, and stair tread coverings using infrared radiant floor tile removal equipment, low-odor mastic remover, and hand-held tools; cleaning, waste packaging, labeling, and off-site disposal in accordance with applicable Federal and State regulations; post-removal air-clearance sampling performed by a qualified third party using Transmission Electron Microscopy (TEM), with clearance results not exceeding 70 structures per square millimeter; and demobilization and restoration of the work area to a clean, safe, and usable condition. The Government contemplates award of a Firm-Fixed-Price contract with a 10-calendar day period of performance after issuance of the Notice to Proceed. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 10:00 AM EDT ON SEPTEMBER 14, 2026.
