

NATO CCMS Pilot Study on Prevention and Remediation in Selected Industrial Sectors

- **Approved by CCMS Plenary fall 2002**
- **Three year study (2003-2006)**
- **Focus on single industrial sector each meeting**
- **Deal with prevention of contamination as well as monitoring and cleanup issues**
- **Limit meetings to three days**
- **Restrict Tours de Table in order to meet time limit**
- **Site visit optional depending on the agenda**
